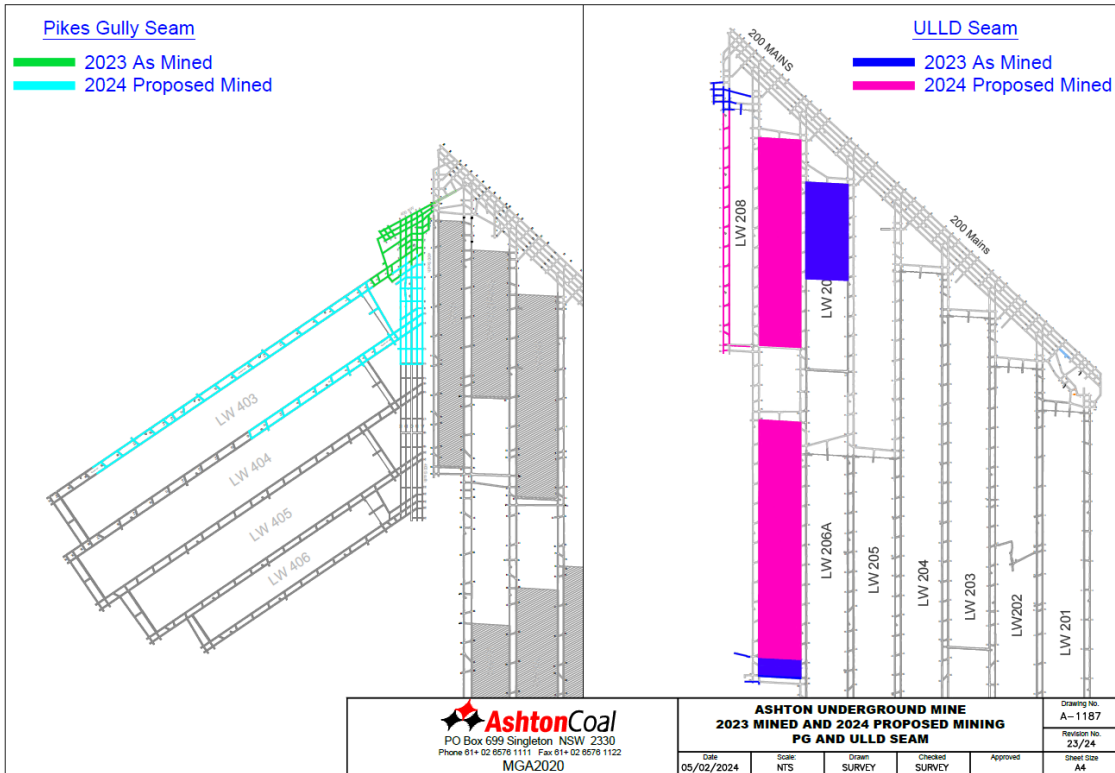

Environmental Update

- Monthly noise monitoring undertaken. No issues identified.
- Ancillary approvals progressing (Extraction Plan, Management Plans etc).
- Bi-annual Fauna monitoring completed in January.
- Threatened species observed during surveys were:
 - grey-crowned babbler (*Pomatostomus temporalis temporalis*)
 - brush-tailed phascogales (*Phascogale tapoatafa*)
 - Latham's snipe (*Gallinago hardwickii*)
 - masked owl (*Tyto novaehollandiae*)

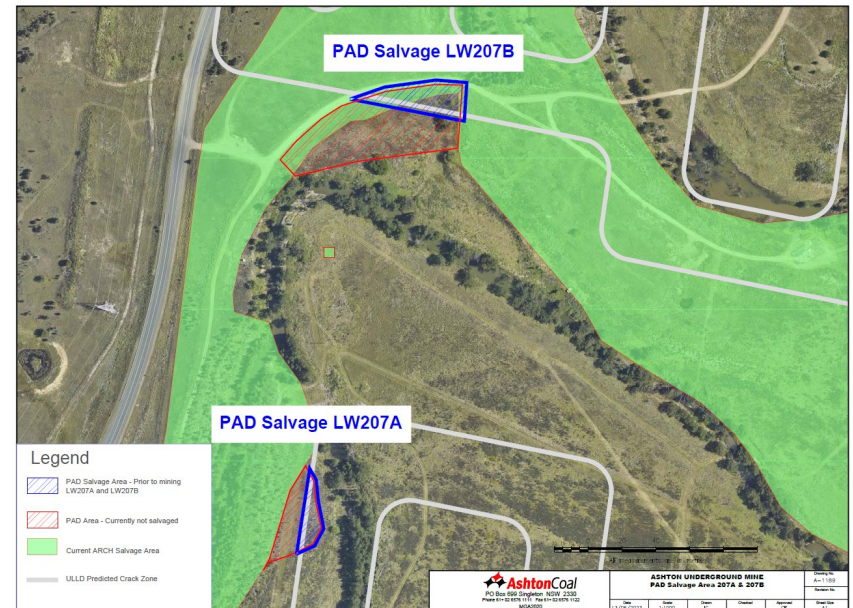
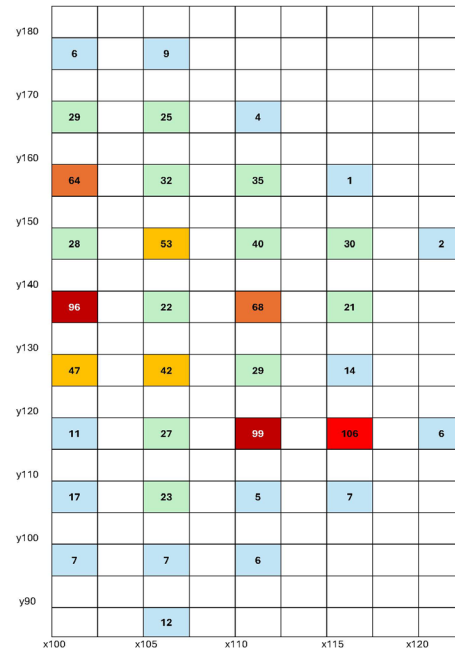
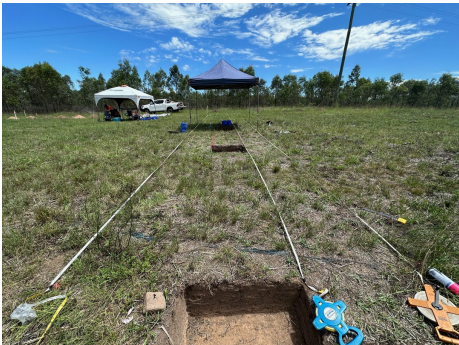
Environmental Update (cont.)

- Creek geomorphology assessment completed along Bowmans Creek Diversion to assess how the diversion works are performing. Waiting on final report from Dr Chris Gippel.
- EPL Annual Return submitted.
- Annual Review reporting is being compiled and is due for submission end of March.

Environmental Update (cont.)

LW207A Salvage – AHIMS Site 37-3-0496

- Aboriginal archaeological salvage excavations have commenced at recorded Aboriginal archaeological site #37-3-0496. Site is located on an elevated terrace above Bowmans Creek and comprises of Aboriginal stone artefacts located within the subsurface soil deposits.
- A grid was placed across the area to be impacted by subsidence and a series of 1m x 1m archaeological test probes excavated to determine the densities of artefacts and where an open area excavation may be required.
- Works undertaken with the ACOL Registered Aboriginal Party groups.
